<u>Professional Standards</u> <u>Program</u>

One of the benefits of being a member of SCAEOP is an opportunity to earn the distinction of being a certified office professional.

As you may or may not know, PSP (Professional Standards Program) is a certificate you can earn. Obtaining your PSP is the first step to becoming a Certified Educational Office Employee (CEOE). Your PSP and CEOE are distinctions that office professionals can attain by being members of National Association of Educational Office Professionals (NAEOP). Listed below is an overview table of the requirements needed to obtain your PSP/CEOE. This certification program is based on **education**, work experience, **professional development points**, and **association involvement**(responsibility).

At A Glance

Professional Standards Program (PSP) Certificate Requirements-if you do not have a degree the criteria is noted below:
